## Township of Wentworth is declared the winner, thanks to its W.I.L.D. Trust!

In the winter of 2022, Éco-corridors laurentiens held its first edition of its **Gala de la conservation** for the MRCs and municipalities of the Laurentian region! The Gala is an opportunity to publicly recognize the efforts made by municipal authorities for projects in natural lands conservation, as well as to share municipal conservation actions with the entire region and

its citizens.

Eight municipalities or MRCs submitted their nominations for the Gala. Following a deliberation by the selection committee composed of representatives of environmental organizations in the Laurentian region, the **Municipality of the Township of Wentworth** was awarded the **Innovation prize for its project of creating a trust for the conservation of natural lands in its territory.**

Éco-corridors laurentiens came to present us with an award and congratulated us in person for our conservation project, which distinguished itself among the applications received.

The Deputy of Argenteuil, Mrs. Agnès Grondin, also wished to congratulate us for our award. *"Forests, mountains, valleys, rivers and lakes are abundant on the territory of this municipality, which gives great importance to its natural heritage, with good reason. By creating a conservation trust, it is ensuring that its natural spaces are rigorously managed for the benefit of current and future generations. I congratulate the municipality for its vision! Every Quebec's small municipalities and even the largest ones, should be inspired by the Municipality of the Township of Wentworth",* said Mrs. Grondin.
