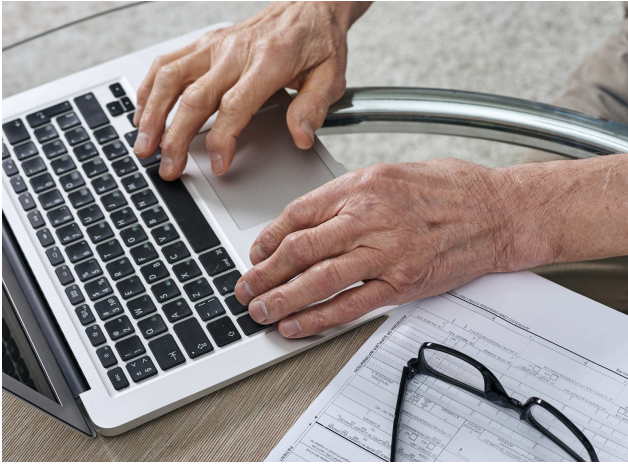
Autoroute 50: regional campaign
