## Dog license

In accordance with municipal regulations, main residences are required to register their dog with the Municipality. This simple and mandatory process helps ensure public safety and promote a responsible environment for all citizens.

To register your dog, simply complete a form available at town hall or on the Municipality's website. The annual cost of the license is set at \$10 per dog. Payment for the license can be made in person at Town Hall.

Renewal of the dog license must be completed each year before June 3.
