

A service economy

On August 9, the Township of Wentworth surveyed residents for their views on collection days and frequencies. We have heard your wish to modify the days and frequency of collection, in order to achieve significant budget savings. Following this citizen consultation, the municipality is very pleased to have received three submissions. Starting in January 2024, collection days will now be every second Tuesday for garbage and recycling! The 2024 Calendar will be available soon.

Winter bin collection

It's your responsibility to clear snow and de-ice your bins to prevent breakage. You must also ensure that your materials are collected. During winter storms, place your bin on your property near the road on the morning of collection.

A distribution of kitchen bins

The Municipality has recently begun distributing kitchen compost bins. Composting helps considerably reduce the amount of organic matter sent to landfill sites. At the same time, it enables the municipality to obtain government compensations for the disposal of residual materials.

Our website has a wealth of information to help you sort materials. In addition, we remind you that the Township of Wentworth has 5 community composters available 365 days a year:

- At the Municipal Garage 114 Louisa Road (adjacent to the Fire Hall)
- At the intersection of Dunany and Boyd roads
- At the intersection of Glen and Charlie Chaplin roads
- At the intersection of Acres and Lac Louisa Sud roads
- At Lake Grace Park


Access to Dunany Country Club


