For the occasion, members are waiting for you with coffee and cookies at the Wentworth Community Center.



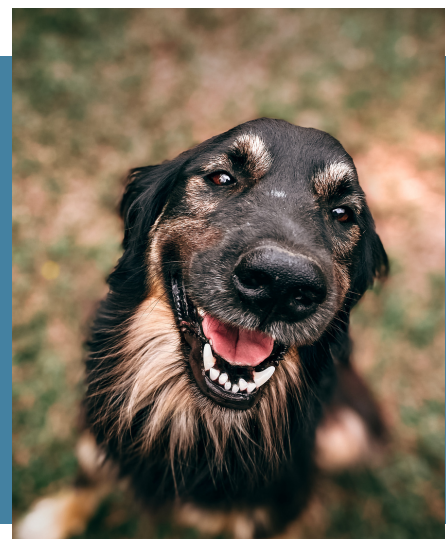
