The M.N.A. for **Argenteuil, David Whissell** made the announcement on March 14th, that financial assistance from the Government of Quebec in the amount of \$43,676 has been awarded for the reconstruction of the outdoor rink and the construction of a new heated building for changing and storage. Immediately after this good news, **Mrs. Lois Armitage, President of Wentworth Recreative Center**, a nonprofit organization, proceeded to announce the launch of a fundraising campaign to complete the financial shortfall amounting to nearly \$50,000.

SPRING IS HERE AND THE SEASON FOR EXTERIOR FIRES



Effective April 1st, permits are required for all open fires **1 meter or less in diameter**. You must call **450-562-0701**, follow the instructions to obtain the voice mail for exterior fires and leave your name, address, phone number on the day that you wish to make a fire.

For an exterior fire larger than 1 meter in diameter, you must call **450-562-0701**, follow the same instructions as above, several days in advance for an appointment with a firefighter to verify the proposed site.

Always clear away combustibles in the vicinity of the fire and make sure that you have a water hose available at all times.

For all emergencies call 911.

Just a reminder that Temporary Carports (Tempos) must be removed **by May 15th** each spring. The last major Zoning Bylaw revision allows for a longer period, i.e. **October 1st until May 15th**. This gives everyone plenty of time to install tempos before the snow flies and remove them after the spring thaw. We thank you for your cooperation and remind you that a \$300-a-day fine may be imposed without further notice.
