**PUBLIC NOTICE FOR ELIGIBLE VOTERS ON THE ELECTOR'S LIST FOR REFERENDUMS OF THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WENTWORTH**

**PUBLIC NOTICE** is given as follows:

At a regular meeting held on June 6<sup>th</sup> 2016, Council adopted By-Law Number 2016-003, Borrowing By-Law to decree a loan in the amount of \$27, 552 to finance the upgrading of the culvert on Pouliot Road.

Eligible voters having the right to be on the elector's list for referendums who are owners of properties served by Pouliot Road of the Municipality of the Township of Wentworth, may request that this By-Law be submitted to a referendum by signing a register for this purpose. Eligible voters must also enter their name, address and voter qualification.

This register will be available on June 21<sup>st</sup> 2016, from 9:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. at the Municipal Office:

The number of signatures required in order for a referendum to be held is 15. The By-Law is deemed approved by eligible voters if said number of signatures is not achieved.

The registration procedure results will be announced on June 21<sup>st</sup> 2016 as soon as possible after closing of the register, at the Municipal Office, at the above-mentioned address.

The By-Law may be reviewed at the Municipal Office at the above-mentioned address from Monday to Friday between 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. or on the Municipal Website [www.wentworth.ca](http://www.wentworth.ca) .

**In order to be an eligible voter on the elector's list for referendums for the Municipality of the Township of Wentworth, the following conditions must be met:**

1. All persons as of June 6<sup>th</sup> 2016 who are not disqualified from voting according to Article 524 of the Law on Elections and Referendums in Municipalities and fulfil the following conditions:
  - be domiciled in the territory of the Municipality of the Township of Wentworth and for at least 6 months in Québec and
  - be of full age, a Canadian citizen and not be under curatorship.
2. All non-resident sole owners of an immovable or non-resident sole occupant of a business establishment who are not convicted of an incapacity to vote and fulfil the following conditions:
  - be owner of an immovable or sole occupant of a business establishment situated in the territory of the Municipality of the Township of Wentworth for at least 12 months;
  - in the case of a natural person, be of full age, a Canadian citizen and not be under curatorship.
3. All undivided non-resident co-owners or non-resident co-occupants of a business establishment who are not convicted of an incapacity to vote and fulfil the following conditions:
  - be an undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-occupant of a business establishment situated in the territory of the Municipality of the Township of Wentworth for at least 12 months;
  - be designated by proxy signed by the majority of the persons who are co-owners or occupants for at least 12 months, as the person who has the right to sign the register or be on the referendum list. This proxy must be produced before or when signing the register.
4. Legal person:
  - be designated by resolution among its members, administrators or employees, a person as of June 6<sup>th</sup> 2016, is a Canadian citizen, of full age, not convicted of incapacity to vote and not under curatorship.

To be eligible to sign the register, an identification card must be presented. The legally accepted identification cards are Driver's Licence or Medical card issued from the Province of Québec, Canadian Passport or any other document that has been issued by the Government or a government department or body or recognised by the Government and is determined by regulation by the Government pursuant to paragraph 4 of section 549 of the Election Act.
