## **BY-LAW NUMBER 2014-002-01**

## BY-LAW MODIFYING BY-LAW NUMBER 2014-002 THE CODE OF ETHICS AND GOOD CONDUCT FOR THE ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WENTWORTH

**WHEREAS** the National Assembly adopted June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2016, Project Law number 83 "An Act to amend various municipal-related legislative provisions concerning such matters as political financing";

**WHEREAS** Article 101 of Project Law number 83 concerning the *Municipal Ethics and Good Conduct Act* (chapter E-15.1.0.1) is modified by the insertion of Article 7.1:

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Council must before September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2016, adopt the modification to their Code of Ethics and Good Conduct for the elected officials of the Municipality of the Township of Wentworth;

**WHEREAS** a notice of motion was given at the regular meeting held on August 1, 2016;

**WHEREAS** a copy of this By-Law was presented to Council no later than two (2) working days before the meeting and that all the members present declare having read the Draft By-Law and waive its reading;

**THEREFORE** it is proposed by Councillor Lorraine Lyng-Fraser and **RESOLVED** that the By-Law be enacted and decreed as follows:

ARTICLE 1 The preamble forms an integral part of this By-Law.

ARTICLE 2 Article 6 entitled "Rules of Conduct" is modified by adding the following section:

## 6.8 - Political Fundraising

It is prohibited for any member of Council of the municipality to make the announcement at a political fundraising event, the realization of a project, the conclusion of a contract or the granting of a subvention by the municipality, unless a final decision on this project, contract or subvention has already been taken by the competent authority of the municipality.

ARTICLE 3 This By-Law shall enter into force in accordance with the Law.
